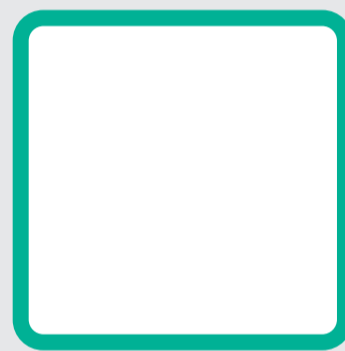

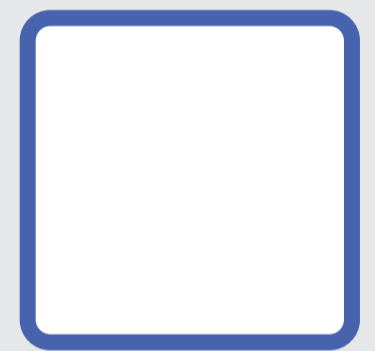

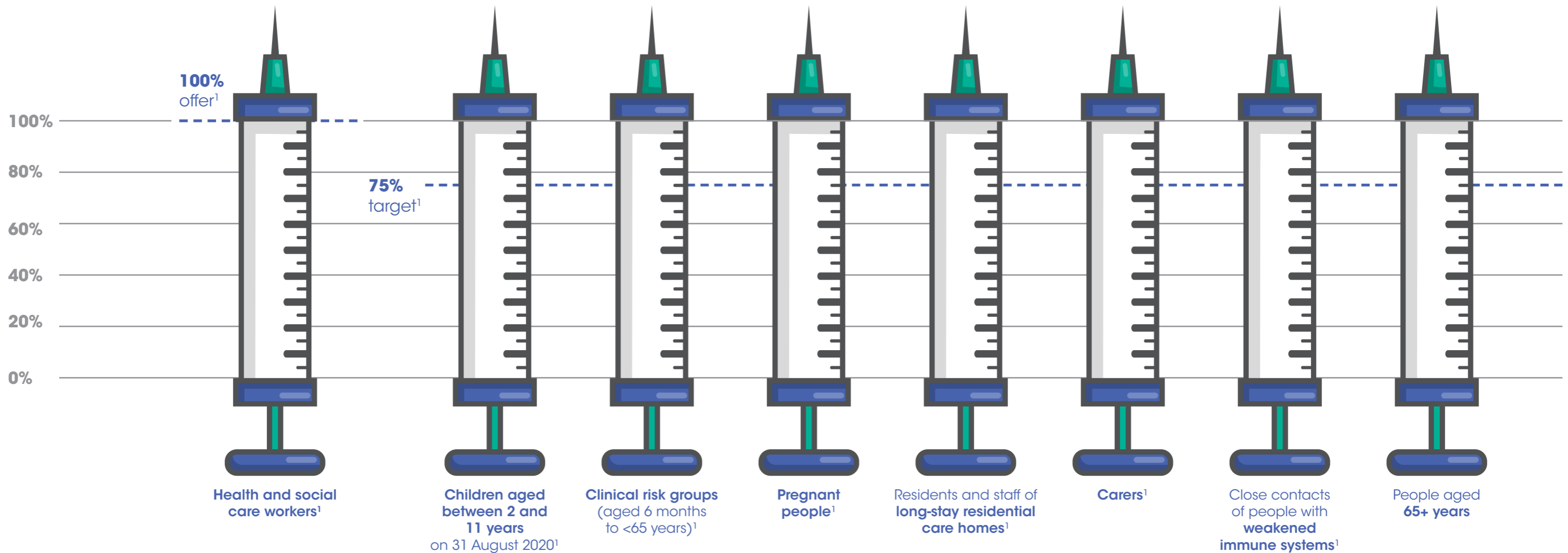
Actively invite **100% of eligible patients** to ensure uptake is as high as possible<sup>2</sup>
